[Lower Triassic, but included here because of unusual features: no ventral shields; 5 genital pores situated atop the buccal shields(?) in interbrachial position; the specific name Ophioderma schistovertebrata refers to the cleft between the two halves of vertebral ossicles (ventral view)]
